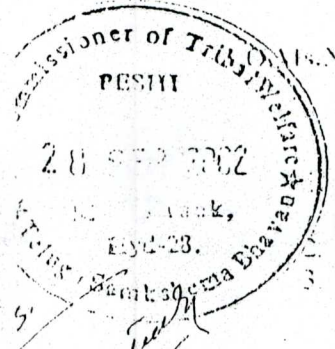

ORDER:

The Member-Secretary, Gurukulam in his letter 3rd read above has furnished the proposal for opening of 4 English Medium Residential Schools at Hyderabad, Warangal, Tirupathi and Vizag.

2. After careful examination of the proposals of Member-Secretary, Gurukulam, Government hereby accord sanction of the following items:

- i) He is permitted to establish four English Medium Residential Schools at Hyderabad, Warangal, Tirupathi and Vizag.
- ii) The above English Medium Residential Schools are under the management of Gurukulam for the benefit of S.T. Students who are otherwise to be covered under the Best Available School Scheme being implemented by the Tribal Welfare Department and run on the same pattern as that of the existing Tribal Welfare Residential Schools under Gurukulam.
- iii) For the current academic year i.e. for 2002-2003, the school sanctioned at Hyderabad will function temporarily at A.P.Tribal Welfare Residential School, Narsapur, Medak District which has got extra accommodation for school and dormitory; till a suitable site is identified in the suburbs of Hyderabad and buildings are completed;
- iv) The other three schools sanctioned at Warangal, Tirupathi and Vizag will be started from the next academic year 2003-2004;
